During the meeting, the Board of Deans also requested the Chairs of the departments to assign reasonable teaching hours and encourage lecturers to conduct scientific research.



QUALITY ASSURANCE OF EDUCATION

Mock accreditation of training programs for Medical Doctors according to ASK2019 standards

From January 23-26, at the Faculty of Medicine, a mock accreditation of the Medical Doctor training program according to ASK2019 standards took place. This accreditation was conducted by the Korea Institute of Medical Education and Accreditation (KIMEE).

This is the first time the Medical Doctor training program has been accredited by KIMEE - an accreditation organization recognized by the World Federation for Medical Education (WFME). The accreditation period lasted from January 23 to January 26 with many interviews with groups writing self-assessment reports, lecturers, students and visits to training facilities to comprehensively evaluate the Medical Doctor training program.

The Faculty of Medicine has accredited the Medical Doctor training program according to 3 sets of regional and world accreditation standards within 2 years. The results of this accreditation round will be a step to create momentum for Medical Doctor training program to meet the accreditation standards of the World Federation for Medical Education (WFME).

Announcement for submission of research proposals to the ISPF Fund, implemented by the British Academy

The British Embassy introduces 8 notices inviting research proposals from the ISPF Fund, implemented by the British Academy.

The program requires a social / humanitiy scientist host, with research proposals on emerging technology management, health, and climate change. The program welcomes the participation of scientists in the fields of nature, engineering, and medicine as collaborators.

These proposals can be led by Vietnamese scientists, but require a research partner in the UK; or vice versa, the British scientist as primary investigator, and the Vietnamese scientist co-investigator.

Note: If lecturers from Vietnamese Institutes intend to be PI, they need to register in advance with British Academy and fill in the Eligibility Assessment information at least 2 weeks before April 10th.

Sponsorship: 200,000 pounds/18 months.




