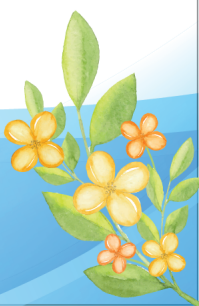

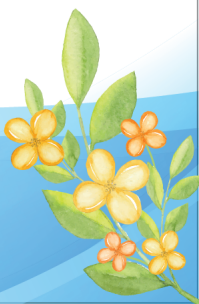




# ADMINISTRATIVE ORGANIZATION

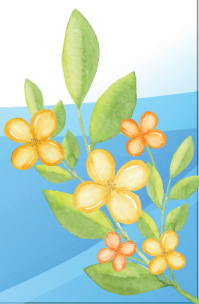




# TRAINING

## Graduation consideration for Medical Doctors in 2023

On September 5, 2023, the 2023 Medical Doctor Graduation Council met with Associate Professor. Ngo Quoc Dat, Vice President in charge of University of Medicine and Pharmacy at Ho Chi Minh City. The Council approved the graduation standards for 2023. As a result, 376 students of the Class of 2017 and 15 students of previous courses passed the graduation exam. The graduation rate of 2017 medical students was 96.16%.

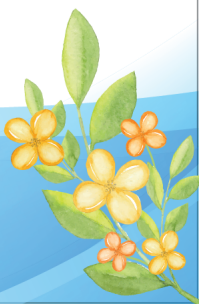

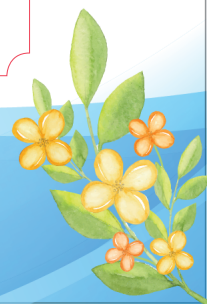

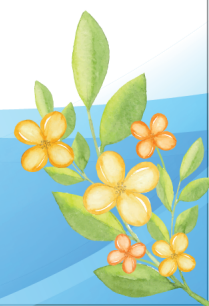




# MEDICAL EDUCATION QUALITY ASSURANCE

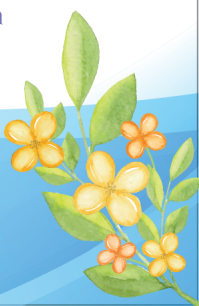

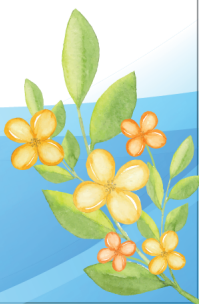
## Workshop on Construction and Evaluation of Multiple-choice exam questions

THE EFFECTS OF THE TRANSFORMING STRESS PROGRAM ON MEDICAL STUDENTS' STRESS MINDSET AND COPING STRATEGIES: A QUASI-EXPERIMENTAL STUDY

**INTRODUCTION**

Stress is a significant concern in medical training along with its well-known negative consequences, and stress management programs have been designed to help medical students as an initiative to improve medical student well-being. However, studies on the impact of stress management on medical students' performance, coping strategies, and performance have been limited. This study examined the effects of the transforming stress program on medical students in a medical university in Vietnam.

**METHOD**

We conducted a quasi-experimental study with intervention for 200 students in intervention group in the first semester and 200 students in control group in the second semester. The 20-week transforming stress program was based on Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, incorporating visualization as a fundamental principle. A multi-measure was developed with variables used to assess students' stress on the daily basis, aiming to enhance the skills learned in the class. Stress Mindset Measure and Brief Coping Questionnaire (Brief Cope) were used to measure stress mindset and coping strategies. Data was collected at baseline (T0), immediately after the training for intervention group (T1), and after six months follow-up on the intervention group (T2).

**RESULTS**

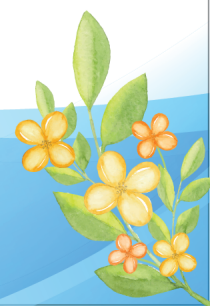
