ADMINISTRATION - ORGANIZATION





Sections to note the conditions for rating and evaluation:

- 1. The evaluation and classification of civil servants for the 2023-2024 acamedic year will be conducted for all lecturers in the department, including lecturers working at units 70% of the time.
- 2. Units with employees signing contracts of less than 6 months must complete a self-criticism form.
- 3. In cases of unpaid leave from 3 months to less than 6 months, the assessment will still be conducted but the quality will not be classified as completing the task well.
- 4. Cases of assessment and classification based on work results and study results: VC-NLĐ sent to study and receive training from 6 months to less than 12 months and VC-NLĐ sent to study under the work-study system, VC-NLĐ sent to study long-term and concentrated for 5 months or more.
- 5. VC-NLĐ who are being sent for long-term training of 12 months or more will be evaluated and classified based on their learning results and attitude towards compliance with regulations at the training facility.
