ADMINISTRATION – ORGANIZATION



On the afternoon of October 30, the Faculty of Medicine held a conference for civil servants and employees in 2024 to summarize the 2023–2024 academic year and set out the direction of activities for the 2024–2025 academic year.

In the 2023 - 2024 academic year, the Faculty of Medicine has achieved the following outstanding achievements:

- The Faculty has 4 groups and 14 individuals receiving certificates of merit from the Minister of Health. In particular, in 2024, 03 lecturers were considered for the title of Outstanding Lecturer at all levels of University of Medicine and Pharmacy at Ho Chi Minh City and 01 lecturer was considered for the title of Outstanding Lecturer by the Ministry of Education and Training:
 - Lecturers considered for the title of Outstanding Lecturer of University of Medicine and Pharmacy at Ho Chi Minh City: Prof. Le Van Cuong, Senior Lecturer, Former Head of Anatomy Department Outstanding Lifetime Lecturer, Assoc. Prof. Nguyen Van Hai, Senior Lecturer, Head of General Surgery Department Outstanding Lecturer at university level and Assoc. Prof. Vo Duy Thong, Senior Lecturer of General Internal Medicine Department Outstanding Lecturer at faculty level.
 - Lecturer considered for the title of Outstanding Lecturer by the Ministry of Education and Training: Dr. Tran Thanh Vy, Lecturer of the Department of Thoracic and Cardiovascular Surgery.
- The Faculty of Medicine has been successful in training with a total of 363 students recognized as graduating as Medical Doctors in the 2018 course, reaching 96.16%. Of which, the percentage of students achieving Good or higher grades is up to 94.4%.
- In addition, continuing education has made many new advances, continuing education courses of departments have increased in both quantity and quality, Multidisciplinary Medical CME is organized periodically every month attracting a large number of delegates to attend. In particular, the Multidisciplinary Medical Conference 2024 was successful with more than 20 multidisciplinary sessions organized, attracting more than 123 presenters and more than 1,000 delegates, including the participation of international presenter Prof. Matt Kemp, Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, National University of Singapore.
- Regarding Scientific Research, the Faculty has 198 articles published in domestic and international journals, of which 67 articles are published in prestigious international journals, accounting for 33.8%.
- Regarding cooperation and projects, the Faculty has officially joined the ASEAN Deans of Medical Sciences network. Expanded partnerships with the International University of Health and Welfare (IUHW), National University of Singapore (NUS), University of Tsukuba and Taipei Medical University (TMU) in student exchange; promoted cooperation with Harvard Medical School (USA), Geneva University School of Medicine (Switzerland) and Texas Tech University El Paso (USA) in curriculum innovation.









In addition to the achievements, in the 2023 - 2024 academic year, the Faculty of Medicine surveyed students' satisfaction with training quality, learning and internship environment with the results that 12 Departments and Modules received high student satisfaction indexes including:



- Year 1: Module from Organs Systems, Department of Embryology Pathology.
- Year 2: Department of Hematology, Department of Oncology.
- Year 3: Department of Food Safety and Hygiene, Department of Endocrinology.
- Year 4: Department of Health Management Organization, Department of Thoracic Surgery Cardiovascular.
- Year 5: Department of Neurosurgery, Department of Geriatrics.
- Year 6: Department of General Surgery, Department of Pediatrics.

The conference also discussed and agreed on the direction of activities for the 2024-2025 academic year in four areas:

- 1. Education and training: integration and international standards.
- 2. Scientific research: practice and international integration.
- 3. Community service: raising the level of University of Medicine and Pharmacy.
- 4. University governance: autonomy and efficiency.

Graduation Ceremony of Advanced Faculty
Development Program 3 (AFDP 3) and Signing of
MOU 3 with Texas Tech Health Sciences Center at El Paso

On October 27, the graduation ceremony of the 3rd Advanced Faculty Development Program (AFDP 3) took place at Pham Ngoc Thach University of Medicine. AFDP 3 is part of the training cooperation framework between University of Medicine and Pharmacy at Ho Chi Minh City, Pham Ngoc Thach University of Medicine and Texas Tech University El Paso for the period 2022 – 2024 (MOU 2). In this graduation session, a total of 18 lecturers were qualified to graduate, including 09 lecturers from University of Medicine and Pharmacy at Ho Chi Minh City.

On the same day, the signing ceremony of MOU3 between University of Medicine and Pharmacy at Ho Chi Minh City, Pham Ngoc Thach University of Medicine and Texas Tech University at El Paso for the period 2025–2027 (MOU 3) also took place.
